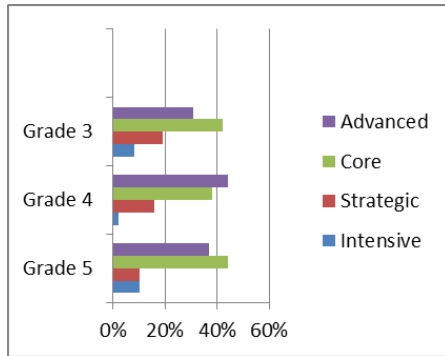

- A School Intervention Team met monthly to support teachers in analyzing school and class-level achievement data.
- Certified Tutors were hired to enhance reading instruction with struggling readers.
- New technology was purchased to upgrade and replace the existing computer labs for students.

### Goal 2: Increase Teacher Quality

- Teachers attend professional development activities throughout the school year.
- Reading teachers participate in Fountas & Pinnell and reading intervention trainings on administering and analyzing the assessments and results.

### Goal 3: Improve School Climate

- Parent Liaison, Mrs. Pat Carpenter acts as an active link between the school, parents, and the community.
- The school's website and school Facebook page are maintained and parents receive weekly newsletter filled with important information. · Parents are given access to the PowerSchool Parent Portal allowing them to access student's grades and attendance information.
