GOALS 2023-2024

* Improve English 2 EOC Scores from 62.7% of students earning a C or higher to 68.3% for an increase of 5.6%.

* Improve Algebra 1 EOC Scores from 21% of students earning C or higher to 32.9% for an increase of 11.9%.

* Decrease the percentage of Woodland HS Students that are chronically absent as of the 180th day from 24% to 20.4% for a decrease of -3.6%.

* Improve the percentage of teachers satisfied with the learning environment from 89.1% to 95% for an increase of 5.9%.

* Improve the percentage of students satisfied with the socio and physical environment from 77.8% to 83% for an increase of 5.2%.

* Improve communications between school and home with use of call-outs, social media, emails, text alerts, newsletters and school website.

* Increase the number of college & career-ready students through increases in SAT/ACT, WIN and ASVAB performance.
