The ReThinkEd Social and Emotional Learning (SEL) and Mental Health programs offer professional development modules, K-12 grade level curriculum, assessments, robust reporting, and data tracking.

ReThinkEd provides a comprehensive and proactive solution to support and promote positive mental health and emotional well-being for the entire community. The curriculum helps students increase awareness and understanding of mental health and mental illness,

encourages the seeking of support and treatment, and fosters the development of critically important social and emotional skills that help to reduce vulnerability to developing a mental illness, create safe and caring school climates, ad form the foundation of mental well-being and success in school and life.
