Achievement Data

ACT Aspire Reading: Seventh grade students scored 423, two points lower than the national average. Eighth grade students scored 422, two points lower than the national average.

Mathematics: Algebra 1 End of Course Examination indicated a 92.9% passage rate which is above the 92.3% ranking of “middle schools with students like ours.”
