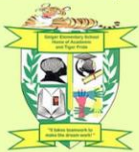


Brief Information About School

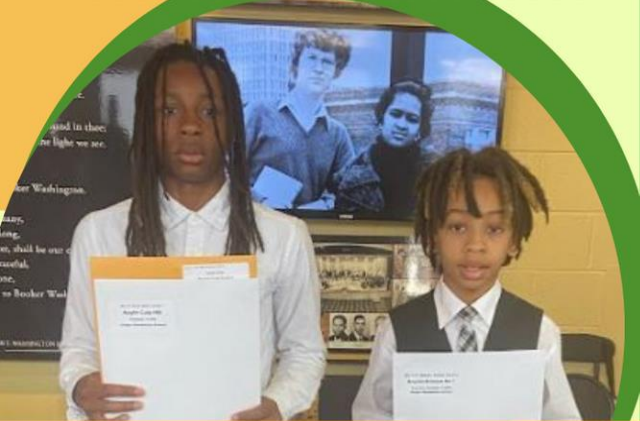
