said Bryant Moses, Wilson High Alumni President. Unveiling this license plate made history at Wilson and throughout the state.



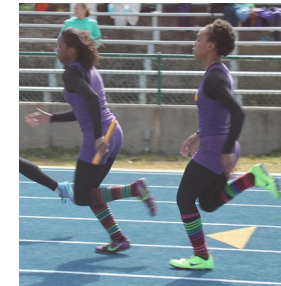

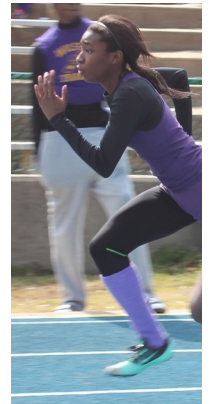
