- Purchase research based instructional materials to be used by special education teachers and the Instructional Coach.
- Provide parenting workshops led by the Math Coach and/or others qualified in the areas of Mathematics and English Language Arts.
- Teachers will provide students, with disabilities, enrichment and remediation in the area of Mathematics before, during, and after school.

Professional Development

Provide professional staff development in the area of Mathematics and English Language Arts to meet the needs of disabled students.

- Grade Level Meetings
- Contract the services of DataWorks to implement-Explicit Direct Instruction into every classroom.
- Data disaggregated through team meetings with all teachers to include PASS and MAP assessments.
- Bi-monthly meetings with administrators to review current data.
