Carver's School Renewal Plan Goals

Student Achievement Goal: By 2023-24, the percentage of African American students scoring “Does Not Meet” on the third grade SC Ready Math assessment will be reduced from the current percentage of 45.3%, according to 2018 data reports, to a percentage of 35%, according to data reports in 2023.

- Hired a third grade teacher to help reduce class size
- Hired two part time interventionists to work with students performing below grade level according to STAR and Linkit
- Provided a parent training on the Big Ideas math curriculum
- Provided a professional development for teachers on DreamBox Learning
- Purchased flashcards, flashmasters, and calculators
- Conducted data meetings with teachers with a focus on math Linkit and math STAR results.

School Climate Goal: By 2023-24, 90% of fourth grade students will be satisfied with the learning environment on the student survey as measured by the SC Report Card.

- Purchased incentives as positive reinforcement for academics and behavior
- Celebrated students as Terrific Kids, PrinciPALs, and Star Students

- Selected 5th grade students run the daily Carver Morning Show and assist younger students as Safety Patrol
- 4th and 5th graders are able to participate in clubs before school.
- Reward students each nine weeks for good citizenship, attendance, and grades

Teacher/Administrator Quality Goal: By 2023-24, teachers in grades K-5 will successfully attend 20 STEM-related professional development sessions.
