### School Climate:

By spring 2024, 98% of teachers, 94% of students, and 97% of parents will indicate satisfaction with the learning environment; 98% of teachers, 90% of students, and 98% of parents will indicate satisfaction with the social and physical environment; and 98% of teachers, 93% of students, and 97% of parents will indicate satisfaction with home-school relations as measured by the state report card.

## ACHIEVEMENT

Strategies Gold (4K), Fast Bridge (5K-2<sup>nd</sup>), and Curriculum and Associates i-Ready (5K- 5<sup>th</sup>) are administered each year during fall, winter, and spring. Formative and summative assessments are administered throughout the school year. Teachers use these data points to assist them in differentiating instruction. This information is used to plan instructional strategies to target and support areas of academic weakness and enrich academic strengths. Teachers also monitor student progress to develop goals with students. Goal setting with students plays an integral part in results on district and state assessments.

Based on i-Ready, we feel a majority of our students will be successful during SC Ready standardized testing. During the 2025 spring administration of i-Ready, 56% of our students met their projected growth target in reading and 51% of our students met their projected growth target in math.
