### Purpose of this Report

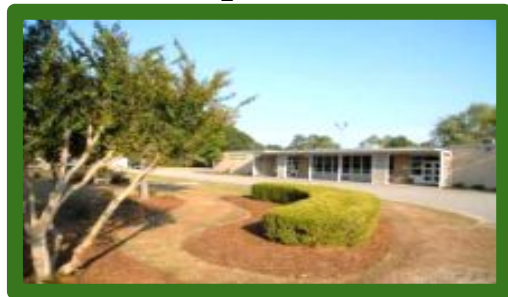
