The 2016-17 school year saw our teachers, students, and parents continue to engage in "STEM-ulating" learning experiences as part of the Project Lead the Way: Launch curriculum in which each grade level integrated two units of study that provided hands-on, minds-on Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics lessons in which students apply critical thinking and problemsolving skills as they deepened their understanding of the
