## SIC ANNUAL GOALS

#### Goal 1: Build Community Support

The SIC recognized building community support as an essential key to fostering a positive school climate. SGES kicked off our social media campaign this year to reach out and inform parents in different ways This campaign includes the Florence 1 App, Instagram, and Facebook posts and updates.

The SIC created a volunteer network, collaboratively hosted monthly Skate Nights, helped implement the Real Men Read mentoring program, and actively advanced a beneficial partnership with the School Foundation and the Fellows in Education. SGES celebrated Women's History Month by inviting women from the community to read to our students, and hosted Florence native author/ publisher Tammie Durant as a guest speaker for our students. SGES partnered with and hosted the Strengthening Family Program to help support

#### Goal 2: Maximize Instructional Time
