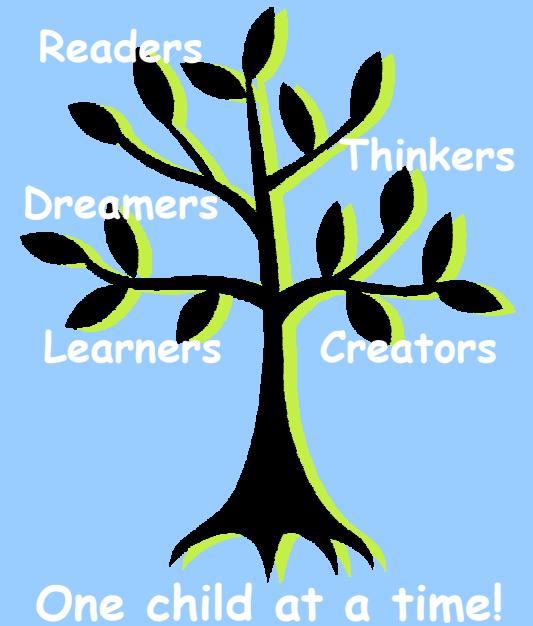

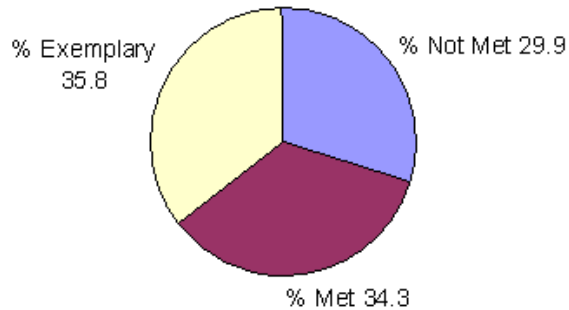

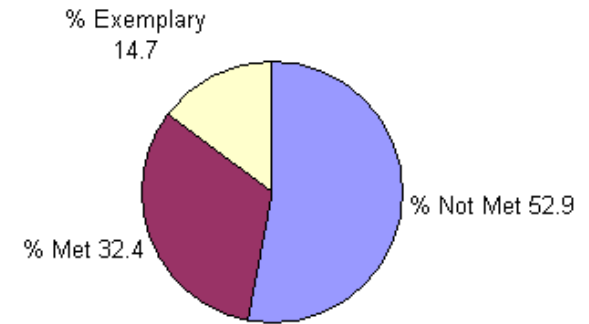

3rd Grade



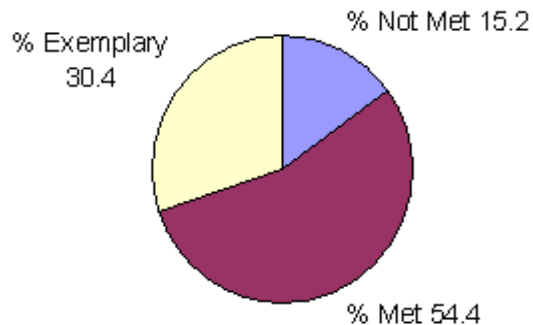
- 4K classes serving 40 four year olds

3rd Grade

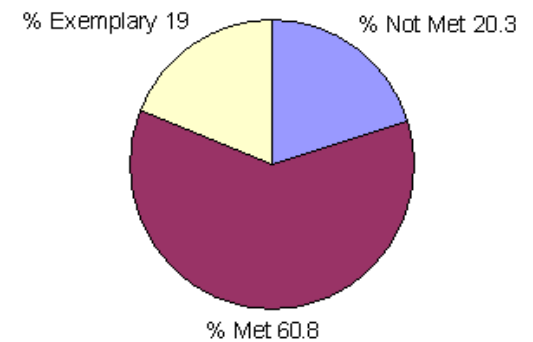


- In-school math interventionists for 3rd, 4th and 5th grade

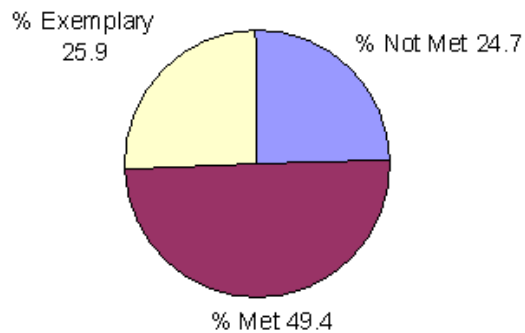
