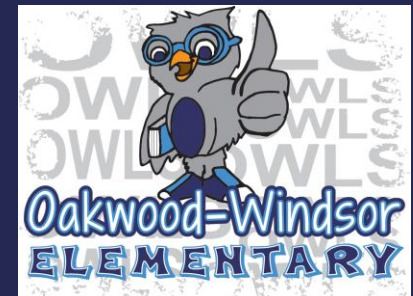

Vision:

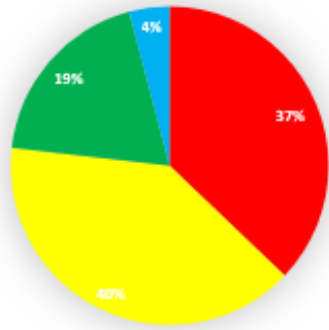
The vision of Oakwood-Windsor Elementary is to grow life-long learners, creators, and problem-solvers by working collaboratively as a community.
