These students were able to attend various field trips offered by the program, also.

This school year, our school had 2 Junior Scholars. These two students, Joseph James and Korey Fulton scored exceptionally high on the PSAT test. They have earned an Award of Merit Certificate, recognition by the local school board, and are invited to attend summer programs at various colleges and universities.

Three students attended the district's annual spelling bee contest after winning the school level spelling bee. Amalyia West placed 1st, Joseph James placed 2nd, and Khiaire Daniels placed 3rd in the school level competition. During the district level competition, Joseph James placed 1st and Amalyia West placed 3rd.

Our school had 6 students pass the Accuplacer test, which will allow them to begin taking college courses at Florence-Darlington Tech while in high school. These students could potentially earn an Associates degree before they graduate from high school.
