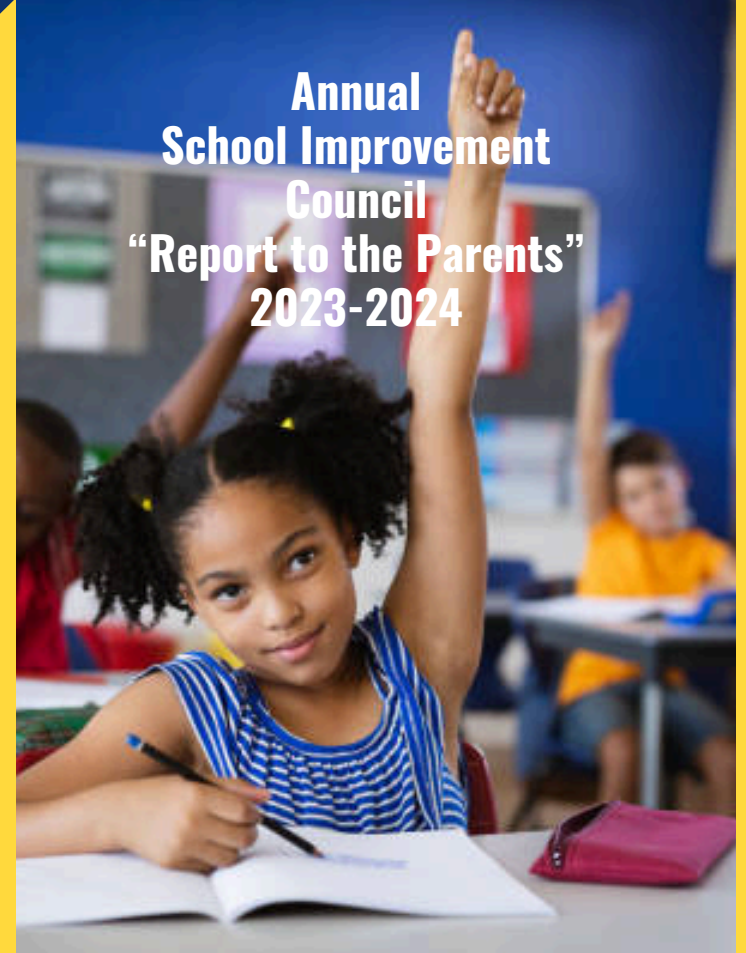

ABOUT US

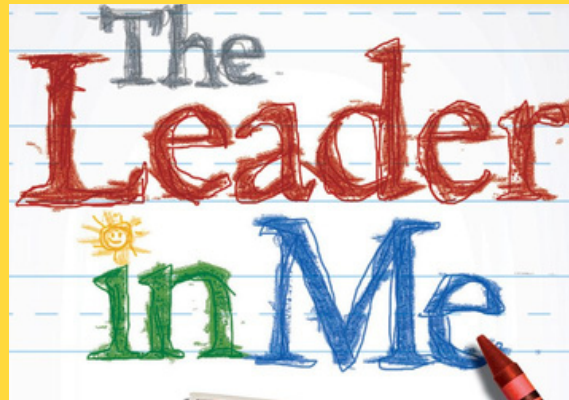
