General Information

Redcliffe Elementary is a Title One school of over 700 students. The School Improvement Council, in conjunction with the PTO and Title One Committee plans goals and activities that support the mission statement of the school which is focused on student achievement.

Student achievement is supported with the use of the science and math labs, COMPASS math tutoring, Fontas and Pinell reading kits, reading intervention for at-risk students, and differentiated, small group instruction in both math and reading. Title One funds help to provide the resources to provide the staff, materials, professional development and technology to deliver many of these interventions.

An additional component to increase student achievement is our focus on character development. This year, Positive Behavior Intervention System was piloted to promote positive behavior choices. Our Academic SIT team also uses a team approach to assist students who are struggling academically.

The PTO provided many opportunities for parental involvement including the Fall Festival, Daddy Daughter Dance, January Jam, Father Son Craft Night, Refresh Redcliffe, and the 5th Grade Etiquette Luncheon. They also provided funding for some building needs including new playground equipment.

All of these activities are evidence that we are implementing our mission of working in partnership with our community to develop responsible citizens who will successfully contribute to our society.

Report Card Information

The Absolute Rating and Improvement rating for Redcliffe Elementary School compared to elementary schools with students like ours is AVERAGE. Redcliffe Elementary School received 69.2 rating, or D, which is a 6.3 point increase from the previous year.
