

We have had a great year at Olanta Magnet setting the course to SAIL towards excellence!

We started this year by focusing on creating a great school culture for both students and staff with the implementation of our PBIS system and integration of Capturing Kids' Hearts. We focused on our improving our academics, particularly in literacy with guidance from our new Literacy Coach, Mrs. Flowers. We focused on reading strategies from Serravallo and Making Thinking Visible strategies from Ritchhart, Church, and Morrison in PLC for immediate transfer into the classroom.

Arts and Science integration opportunities were abundant this year.
