Principal's Message

The mission of Johnsonville Elementary School is to provide a rigorous learning environment through innovative opportunities, dedicated effort, and a family atmosphere. The school will continue to encourage and educate students to be confident, knowledgeable, responsible and productive citizens in an ever-changing world. It is with your assistance that we will be better able to accomplish this task. It takes a team, teachers and parents, working together to accomplish the level of achievement we want to see in our students.

Despite our Covid challenges, our school has moved forward with implementing some new instructional strategies to increase student learning. Students in grades 1-4 now have more consistent math routines such as daily math review, TE21 math practice problems, and the school wide Big Ideas math curriculum. Teachers in grades 4K-1st have been working with the Reading Coach on a book study utilizing Making Sense of Phonics and developing a 5K and first grade ELA curriculum. Teachers in grades 2-4 have been doing a book study on Making Thinking Visible to build a repertoire of student strategies for deeper thinking. These are several instructional strategies that we are looking at fully implementing next school year.

Again, I am looking forward to working with you and your child next school year. Thank you, parents, for your unending support as we dealt with the challenges of the Covid epidemic during the 2020-2021 school year. I am hoping that we will be able to return to our normal school routines for the upcoming school term. I encourage you to visit JES so that we can work together to ensure each student reaches his or her individual potential. Together, we will help your child, and all of our students, develop a love for learning and good life-long habits!
