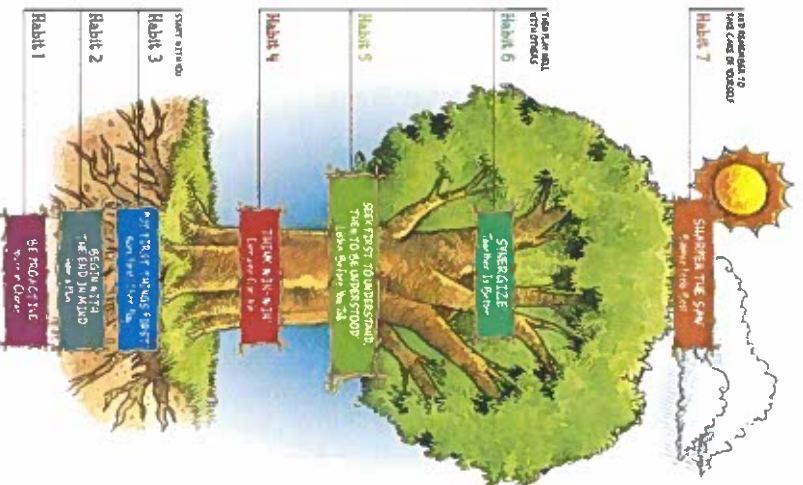


Mission and Vision
