

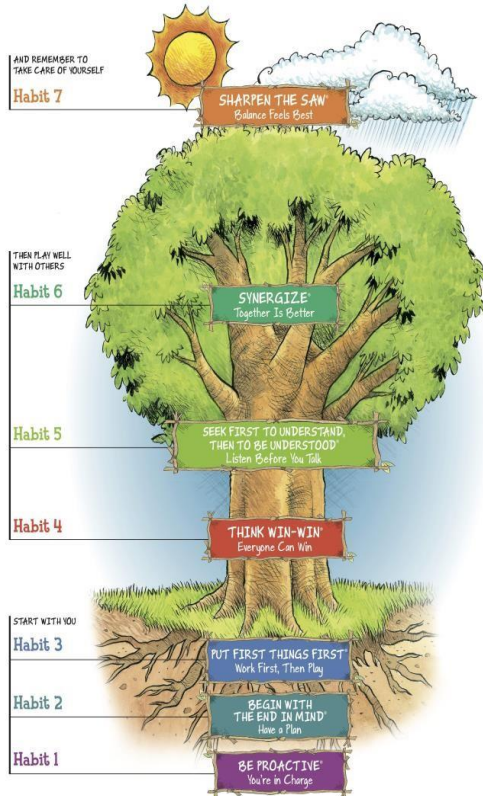
## Mission and VISION
