AHS is a secondary school located in Andrews, South Carolina, United States. It is the oldest continually serving school in Georgetown County, being established in 1922. As of the 2020 census, the town of Andrews had a population of 2,575. Georgetown County's population at that time was 63,404. The town of Andrews is quiet and very community based. Employment opportunities are offered in manufacturing, education, hospitality, recreation, and the service industry. Coastal Carolina University and Horry-Georgetown Technical School are partners of Andrews High School.

Curriculum

AHS utilizes readiness standards for post-secondary education, the workforce, & the military by adopting a culture of high expectations through a rigorous curriculum. Course objectives are aligned with the South Carolina State Curricula, & instructional leaders use results from state & national assessments such as IReady, SAT, ACT, EOC, & Advanced Placement to assist teachers with planning strategies to improve student proficiency. The increased use of technology enhances overall instruction in all classes.

To meet this goal, AHS's flexible 4x4 academic schedule provides students with the opportunity to earn 8 Carnegie units per year in College Preparatory, Honors, Advanced Placement, PACE, Dual Enrollment, Career & Technology Education, & other electives such as Project Lead the Way & Student Leadership. AHS, also, works hard to provide academic assistance to students during the school day by using interventions such as Hive Time and on site peer tutoring. Students also have a variety of clubs, organizations and extracurricular activities in which they can participate and excel both after school & during the day.

AHS provides numerous opportunities to foster better school, student, & community relations by hosting quarterly conferences, freshmen & new student orientation, & regularly scheduled Open Houses. Additionally, parents & community members are invited to attend & participate on the School Improvement Council, FASFA Night, parent conferences, report card pick-up, & in the school's college and career fairs. This year, AHS hosted their 2nd College Decision Day.
