

Academics

AHS utilizes readiness standards for post-secondary education, the workforce, & the military by adopting a culture of high expectations through a rigorous curriculum. Course objectives are aligned with the South Carolina State Curricula, & instructional leaders use results from state & nations assessments such as iReady, SAT, ACT, EOC, & AP to assist teachers with planning strategies to improve student proficiency. The increased use of technology enhances overall instruction in all classes. To meet this goal, AHS's flexible 4x4 academic schedule provides students with the opportunity to earn 8 Carnegie units per year in College Preparatory, Honors, AP, PACE, Dual Enrollment, Career & Technology Education, & other electives such as Jobs for America's Graduates. AHS, also, works hard to provide academic assistance to students during the school day by using interventions such as Hive Time. Students also have a variety of clubs, organizations and extracurricular activities in which they can participate and excel both during & after the school day.
