We are continuing the Professional Learning Teams so teachers can plan lessons, develop common assessments, and closely monitor students' academic progress collaboratively. Power School provides parents the opportunity to monitor their sons' and daughters' academic progress in each class using the parent portal. GHS will continue to provide instruction to students using the 4x4 format.
