CURRICULUM

Georgetown High offers a curriculum that meets the needs of all students by offering college preparatory, gifted and talented, technical preparatory, and special education programs. Students who seek to pursue higher education may take honors (H), Advanced Placement (AP), or Dual Enrollment courses. Georgetown High offers nine Advanced Placement (AP) courses. Georgetown High also offers an extensive selection of vocational and technical courses through its career center. Areas of instruction include cosmetology, automotive technology, graphic communications, business, health occupations, culinary arts, welding, agricultural science, and building construction.

SC transitioned to a 10-point Grade Scale in 2016-17. Prior year courses were evaluated on a 7-point Grade Scale (see below).
