About Georgetown Middle——

Georgetown Middle School is located in the city of Georgetown, an urban community with a population of more than 12,500. The city is 60 miles north of Charleston and 30 miles south of Myrtle Beach. The town was originally names George Town and is the third oldest city in South Carolina. Many tourist come to Georgetown's historic district every year for tours of local plantations, historic homes, and churches. J.B. Beck Middle School was established as a middle school in 1978 and changed its name to Georgetown Middle School in August of 2001 when the new building was officially opened. Today, Georgetown Middle School serves the middle school population of Georgetown and some of its adjacent rural areas. There are four main elementary feeder schools: Maryville, McDonald, Kensington, and Sampit. Georgetown Middle School is the largest middle school in the district with a population of approximately eight hundred seventy-one (871) students. The socioeconomic status of the community is largely average to low-middle class, with many blue-collar and seasonal workers. The student body is reflective of an urban community with a large percentage of parents in domestic careers, touristrelated activities, local businesses, and employees of two major industries (International Paper Company and Mittal Steel Corporation).
