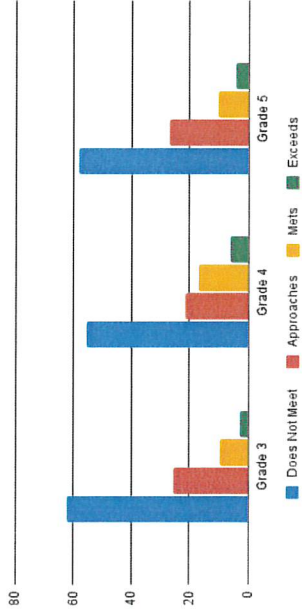

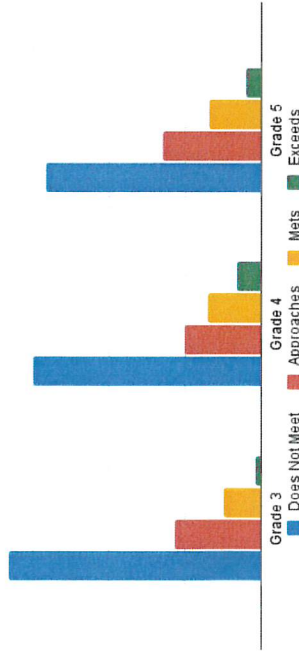

### English Language Arts (Reading and Writing)

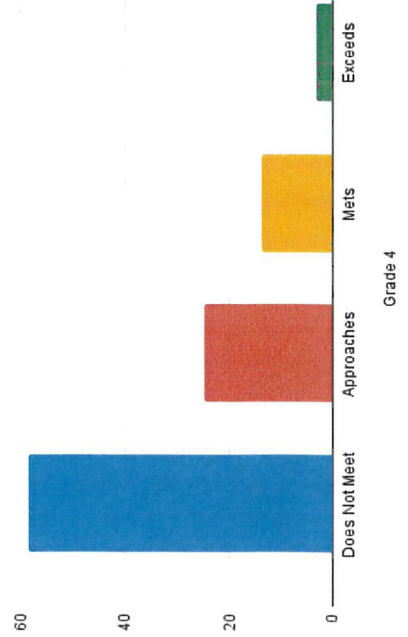


### Mathematics

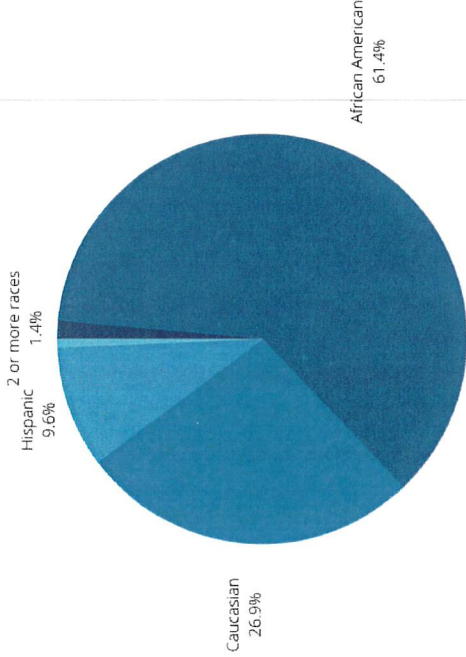


## 2021 SCPASS Test Scores
