



OUR PERFORMANCE GOALS

- THE PERCENTAGE OF STUDENTS IN GRADES 3 THROUGH 5 WHO WOULD SCORE MET AND EXCEEDS IN MATH AS MEASURED BY SC READY WILL INCREASE BY 30% BY MAY 2023.
