Waccamaw Elementary School serves pre-school to third grade students. Universal breakfast and lunch, which provides all students with access to free breakfast and lunch, are served daily. Currently, there are five hundred twenty seven (527) students enrolled at WES: three hundred eighty five (385) Caucasians, one hundred twelve (112) African Americans, Twenty six (26) Hispanics and four (4) Asian. Two hundred forty six (246) of our students are female and two hundred eighty one (281) are males. Of those, seventy four (74) students qualify for special education services which includes both resource and self-contained classes. In addition, five (5) of our students have limited English proficiency.


