Waccamaw Elementary School serves pre-school to third grade students. Universal breakfast and lunch, which provides all students with access to free breakfast and lunch, are served daily. Currently, there are four hundred forty (440) students enrolled at WES: two hundred ninety five (295) Caucasians, one hundred eleven (111) African Americans, twenty five (25) Hispanics and four (4) Asian. Two hundred four (204) of our students are female and two hundred thirty six (236) are males. Of those, thirty six (36) students qualify for special education services which includes both resource and self-contained classes. In addition, ten (10) of our students have limited English proficiency.

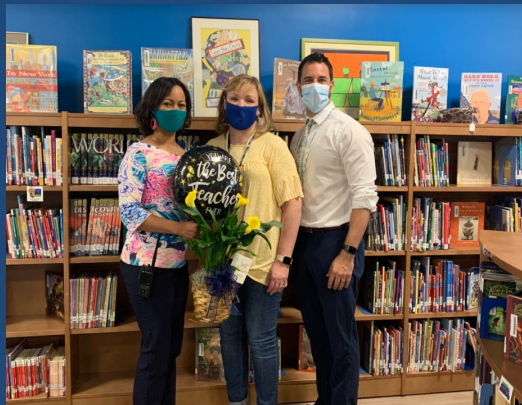

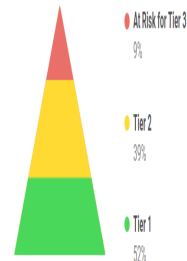

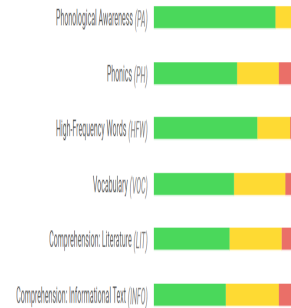
