Waccamaw Elementary School serves pre-school to third grade students. Universal breakfast and lunch, which provides all students with access to free breakfast and lunch, are served daily. Currently, there are four hundred seventy-nine (479) students enrolled at WES: three hundred thirty-six (336) Caucasians, one hundred six (106) African Americans, Thirty (30) Hispanics and six (6) Asian. Two hundred twenty-six (226) of our students are female and two hundred fifty-three (253) are males. Of those, sixtyseven (67) students qualify for special education services which includes both resource and selfcontained classes. In addition, nine (9) of our students have limited English proficiency.


