Waccamaw Elementary School serves pre-school to third grade students. Universal breakfast and lunch, which provides all students with access to free breakfast and lunch, are served daily. Currently, there are five hundred fifty five (555) students enrolled at WES: three hundred ninety nine (399) Caucasians, ninety four (94) African Americans, thirty three (33) Hispanics and five (5) Asians. Two hundred fifty one (251) of our students are female and three hundred and four (304) are males. Of those, eighty eight (88) students qualify for special education services which includes both resource and self-contained classes. In addition, five (5) of our students have limited English proficiency.






