- Use the Leader in Me framework to nurture student leadership, foster a culture of trust, and boost academic success to prepare all to excel.

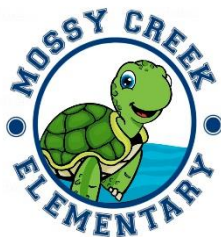

## Progress on SIC Goals for 2023-2024

### Goal 1: Increase Student Achievement

Mossy Creek Elementary supports student growth and teaching by using Fountas & Pinnell, FastBridge, and MAP to monitor and guide instruction. ACPSD is a 1:1 school using computer assisted instruction to provide every student a personalized learning path. All teachers use small group intervention to supplement reading instruction with struggling readers. Voyager, Read 180, and System 44 Reading Programs provide interventions for at risk students.

### Goal 2: Increase Teacher Quality

Teachers attend professional development activities throughout the school year, including weekly PLC meetings. Staff development was provided for full implementation of the ACPSD literacy framework. Reading teachers participated in Fountas & Pinnell and reading intervention trainings on administering and analyzing the assessments results.

### Goal 3: Improve School Climate

School-wide surveys were sent home to parents in the spring of 2023 to measure progress. Teachers, students, and parents indicated satisfaction at the rate of 86.9% for school home relations, 88.9 % for the learning environment, and 87.6% stratification of the social and physical environment. The school's website and social media accounts are maintained, and parents receive a monthly newsletter and calendar filled with important dates and information. Parents are given access to PowerSchool Parent Portal allowing them to access student's grades and attendance information.
