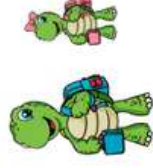

Mossy Creek Elementary Core Priorities

It is the policy of the administration, faculty, and staff of Mossy Creek Elementary to:

- Plan and deliver core instruction with a strong focus on student engagement that will provide a solid foundation that prepares all students for a successful educational career.
- Provide a safe and nurturing environment with authentic learning experiences.
- Establish a sense of community with all students, faculty, and staff through community partnerships and home-school relations.
- Use the Leader in Me framework to nurture student leadership, foster a culture of trust, and boost academic success to prepare all to excel.



Progress on SIC Goals for 2026-2027

Goal 1: Increase Student Achievement

Mossy Creek Elementary supports student growth by using HMH Structured Literacy, FastBridge, Heggerty, and iReady. I to monitor and guide instruction. ACPSD is a 1:1 district using computer-assisted instruction to provide every student with a personalized learning path. All teachers use small group intervention to supplement reading instruction with struggling readers. Read 180, UFLI, Lexia, ONCE and Read Naturally Reading Programs provide interventions for at-risk students.

Goal 2: Increase Teacher Quality

Teachers attend professional development activities throughout the school year, including weekly PLC meetings. Staff development was provided for full implementation of the ACPSD literacy framework. Teachers participated in LETRS and reading intervention trainings on administering and analyzing the assessment results.

Goal 3: Improve School Climate

School-wide surveys were sent home to parents in the spring of 2025 to measure progress. Teachers, students, and parents indicated satisfaction at the rate of 95.6% for school-home relations, 91.9 % for the learning environment, and 93% stratification of the social and physical environment. The school's website and social media accounts are maintained, and parents receive a monthly newsletter and calendar filled with important dates and information. Parents are given access to PowerSchool Parent Portal and the Thrill Share App, allowing them to access students' grades, attendance information, and communication between teachers and parents..
