

The mission of Mossy Creek Elementary School is to give all students a quality education by focusing on student learning and standards based activities to prepare them to become productive citizens and lifelong learners.

SIC Annual Goals

1. By Spring 2014, 90% of students in ELA and 85% of students in Math will score at Met or Exemplary level on state testing.

A Curriculum Coach was hired to assist in the alignment of curriculum to the Common Core State Standards and best practices teaching to improve student achievement. School wide writing was implemented across the curriculum in all grades. A math tutor was hired to work with students based on MAP and PASS scores. These scores show improvement.

2. By Spring 2014, 100% of Mossy Creek teachers will maintain highly qualified status.

Staff development was provided for improving math instruction and implementing Common Core standards. Teachers participated in book studies and best practices observations. One hundred percent of Mossy Creek's teachers are highly qualified.

3. By Spring 2014, 86% of stakeholders will indicate satisfaction with the learning environment, social and physical environment, and school-home relations as measured by the state report card.

School wide surveys were sent home to parents in the spring of 2013 to measure progress. Teachers, students, and parents indicated satisfaction at the rate of 87.9%.

Student Achievement

Mossy Creek received an A Rating on the Federal Accountability Report for 2012.

Mossy Creek was rated Average in both the Absolute and Improvement Categories on the South Carolina School Report Card.

Mossy Creek students continue to show gains in all administrations of the MAPS tests. Every grade experienced a score gain in the Winter Administration.
