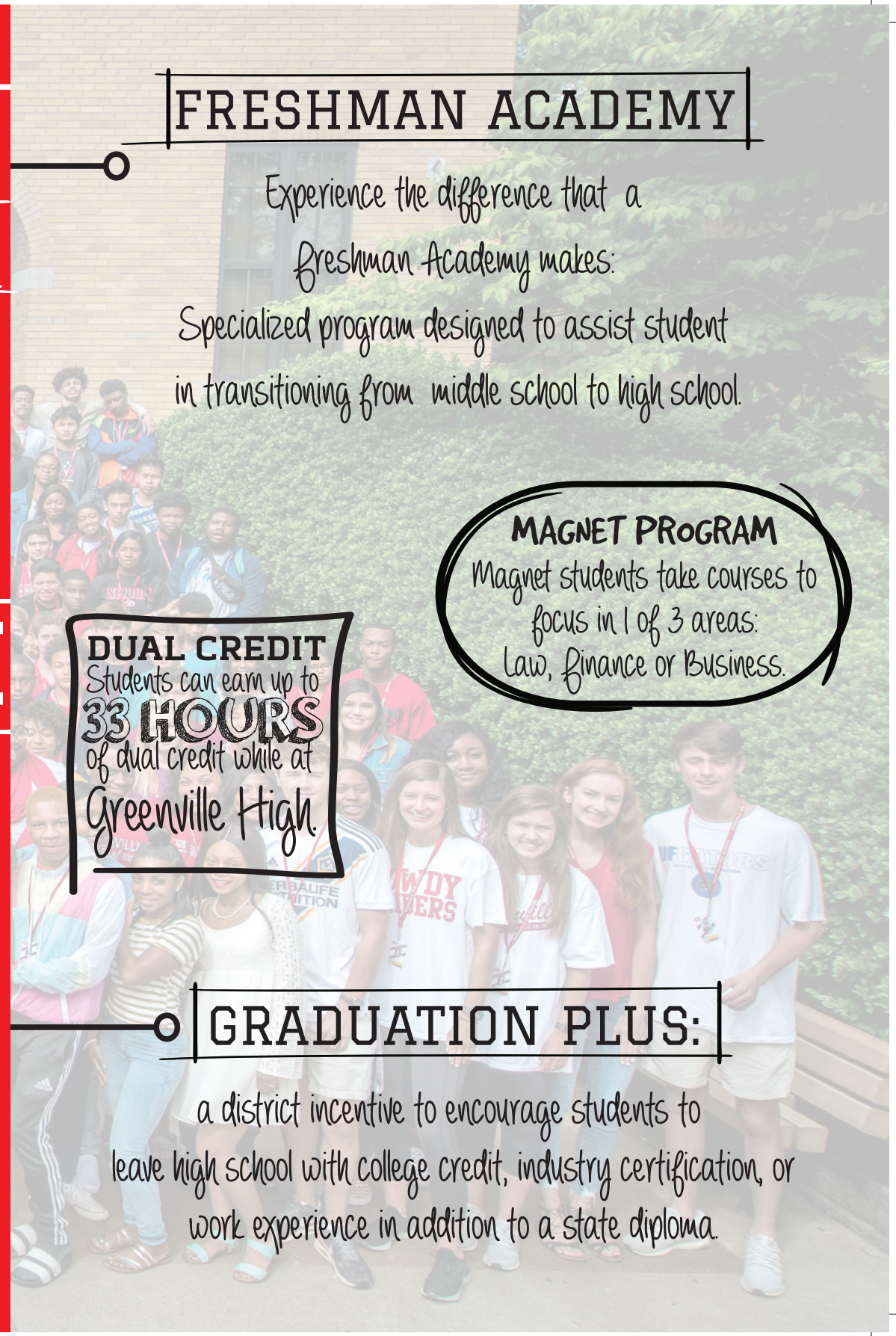
MAGNET PROGRAM

DUAL CREDIT Students can earn up to 33 HOURS of dual credit while at Greenville High.

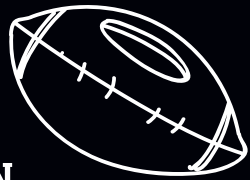
GRADUATION PLUS:

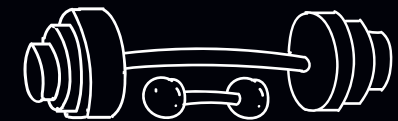
