In a challenging and supportive atmosphere, Greer High School provides all students opportunities to excel in academics, arts and athletics, as well as to prepare for social, civic and occupational responsibilities.

SIC Annual Goals

SIC annual goals focused on the goals established in the 2007-2013 Portfolio School Improvement plan focused on the following:

- Improving Student Attendance—Actions taken Included adding an instructional aide to intervene with students and parents to develop goals for improving student attendance or, to refer truant students to the Attendance Supervisor and Court. School based policy on tardiness was also implemented this school year that has dramatically reduced student tardiness to school.
- Improve Graduation Rate—Actions taken include systemic efforts to assist students in academic difficulty; offer Seat Time Recovery to aide students that have exceeded the number of days allowed for credit; and for guidance counselor assistance with students needing to earn additional credits through online and Twilight school opportunities.
- Improvement in Student Achievement—Actions include full utilization of the 4x4 block schedule in order to accelerate students needing multiple courses in one year. Flex time added to assist students who may need a full-year of English or Math. Advisory period also provided additional opportunities for focused instruction in the basic skills.

Student Achievement

The South Carolina Department of Education provides each public school an annual school report card that provides an absolute rating and a growth rating. The following are comparisons over the past five years.
