
Riverside High School earned **EXCELLENT** on the 2021-2022 SC School Report Card!

Reaching Higher Standards

During the 2021-2022 academic year, Riverside High School students and faculty continues to collaborate together to reach higher standards. Our graduation rate increased from 90.4% in 2020-2021 to 92.2% in 2021-2022. Riverside scored higher than both the district and state on the overall student performance in all four End of Course tests. With 24 AP classes offered, Riverside earned a 72% pass rate on AP exams with scores of a three or higher. Students scored higher than the state and nation on both the SAT and ACT. Riverside has successfully increased our graduation rate towards pre-pandemic rates. Within the class of 2022, there were 442 students who earned college or career readiness. Further career readiness scores showed 92.4% of Riverside students earned the Work Keys certificate.
