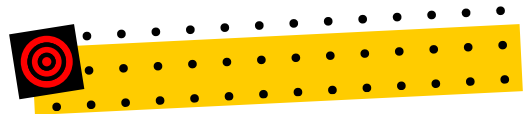

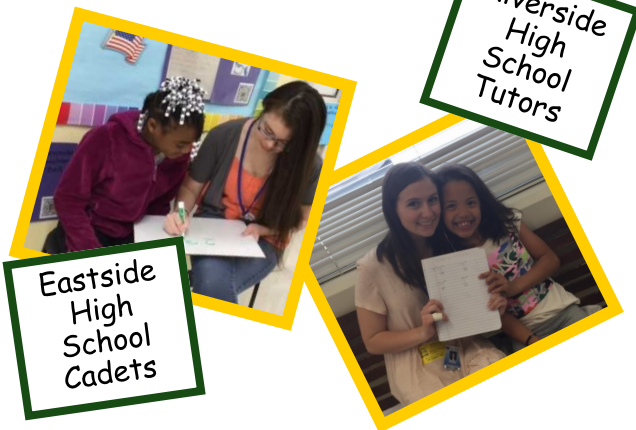

- Recognition programs for students and staff



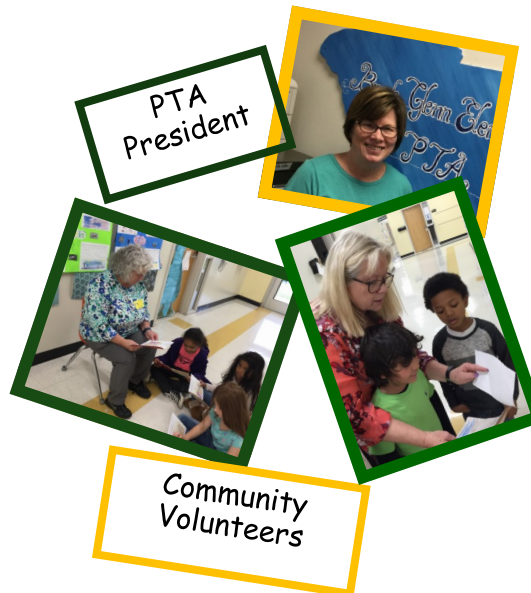
School Report Card Ratings
