

Academic Focus

We anticipate that our students will continue to make educational gains in student achievement. In order to achieve this goal, the school's academic focus, this year, has included the following:

- All 3rd-5th Grade classrooms support the use of 1:1 devices. Each student uses a Chromebook to enhance their educational experiences.
- Teachers used common formative assessments and benchmark data to make instructional decisions to meet the needs of their students.
- We continued to build foundational reading skills by focusing on the Interactive Read Aloud and the Balanced Literacy Framework.
- To continuously improve student-centeredness and differentiation to meet student needs, many teachers began using a small group guided math approach.
