Academic Focus

We anticipate that our students will continue to make educational gains in student achievement. In order to achieve this goal, our school's academic focus can be seen below:

- All third through fifth grade classrooms are equipped with 1:1 devices. These Chromebooks enhanced educational experiences and student engagement.
- Common formative assessments were used to analyze benchmark data and make instructional decisions to meet the needs of all students.
- Our school targeted foundational reading skills by focusing on the Balanced Literacy Framework, specifically, guided reading and mini-lessons.
- A small group guided math approach was integrated into instruction to improve student-centeredness and differentiation.
