Our Goals

- During the 2014-2015 school year, 57% of GMS students will meet or exceed their growth goal on MAP Math as measured from fall to spring.
- During the 2014-2015 school year, 77% of our students will score at or above the benchmark on the ACT Aspire Math Test.
- During the 2014-2015 school year, 63.5 % of our students will meet or exceed their growth goal on the MAP Reading as measured from fall to spring
- During the 2014-2015 school year, 73% of our students will score at or above the benchmark on the ACT Aspire ELA Test..

Student Achievement

On the 2014 State Report Card Greer Middle achieved an absolute ratings of AVER-AGE and an improvement rating of Average.

The school met all except 3 objectives for AYP (Adequate Yearly Progress) This resulted in a Not Met status. Greer Middle did not meet the objective for math and ELA for one sub-group and did not meet the objective in math for another.

The percentages of our students scoring MET or EXEMPLARY on PASS for 2014 as indicated on our School Report Card were: Math—74.2%

Reading-70.1%

Science-72.9%

Social Studies-74.7%

Writing-72%

AYP is based on meeting objectives in several areas including a percentage of students on PASS and ACT, their performance on the test, and their attendance.
