
LAST, BUT NOT LEAST:

This school year, SIC Members were able to serve as volunteers for the Daddy/Daughter Dance, Mother/Son Game Night and other functions to promote literacy within the LFE Community. SIC Members assisted with serving a free dinner provided by the school for all attendees.

In looking ahead for next year, the Council has procured the purchase of "birthday rocks", as seen at many other local schools to add to our culture and climate of celebrating one another at LFE! SIC contacted Sandy Flat Rock Quarry and they agreed to provide two rocks, one for each of our two entrances. These should be in place and ready for rental at the beginning of school in the fall of 2023.
