LMS Academic Progress

In the spring of 2022, students took the SC READY for ELA, Math, and Science (6th Grade ONLY). Over half of our students took the ACCESS for English Language Learners. The test results demonstrated growth in many areas. On the ELA Assessment for grades 6-8, 19.6% met or exceeded expectations (6th – 23.3; 7th – 14.9; 8th – 20.8). On the Math Assessment, 7.7% met or exceeded expectations (6th – 12.0; 7th – 6.2; 8th – 5.3). On the Science Assessment, 28.7% 6th graders met or exceeded expectations. Of the 252 assessed students on the ACCESS for ELLs, 26.85% were proficient and exited ESOL services.
