

On behalf of our School Improvement Council, we present our Annual Report as a summary of the accomplishments of the 2019-2020 school year.

Mauldin Elementary is proud to serve as a Leader in Me school, supporting students academically and socially. Leader in Me focused classrooms help students develop academic goals while cultivating their leadership potential. During the 2019-20 school year, Mauldin Elementary earned recognition by being named a Leader in Me Lighthouse School.

Academically, Mauldin received a SC School Report Card rating of Excellent. SCReady Assessment showed growth in the area of math with 62% of students in Grades 3-5 scoring mastery or above, an increase of 7% from the previous year.

SCReady scores showed growth in ELA with 58.5% of students in Grades 3-5 achieving mastery or above, an increase of 9.5% over the previous year. The SIC supported reading initiatives throughout the school, including adding books to classroom libraries and hosting a family reading night.

The Mauldin Elementary chapter of the National Beta Club participated in the state convention bringing home 19 awards including; first place in Songfest, Robotics and Living Literature.

Mauldin continues to provide quality educational and social emotional experiences to help children succeed .
