

On behalf of our School Improvement Council, we present our Annual Report as a summary of the accomplishments of the 2020-2021 school year.

Mauldin Elementary is proud to serve as a **Leader in Me**® Leader in Me school, supporting students academically and socially. Leader in Me focused classrooms help students develop academic goals while cultivating their leadership potential. During the 2019-2020 school year, Mauldin Elementary earned recognition by being named a Leader in Me Lighthouse School.

Academically, Mauldin received a SC School Report Card rating of EXCELLENT. SCReady Assessment showed growth in the area of math with 62% of students in grades 3-5 scoring mastery or above, an increase of 7% from the previous year.

SCReady scores showed growth in ELA with 58.5% of students grade 3-5 achieving mastery or above, an increase of 9.5% over the previous year. The SIC supported reading initiatives throughout the school, including:



**BUS BOOKS** - books for students to read on our longest bus routes

**READING LINKS** - a school-wide initiative to encourage a love of casual reading



**BOOK VENDING MACHINE** - the fund-raising and purchase of a book vending machine, giving students an opportunity to pick out and keep a book of their own

Mauldin continues to provide quality educational, social, and emotional experiences to help our children succeed.


In the 2020-21 school year, students in grades 2-5 were tested to determine mastery of state standards. Each grade level tested **well above the district average** in ELA and Math.
