

Purpose of the Report:

To give the annual report to our community concerning Northwood's progress towards its goals and objectives as outlined in our strategic plan. The results are based on the fall 2016 to the spring 2017 NWEA MAP results.

Goal #1: During the 2016-2017 school year, the percentage of students (grades 6-8) meeting/exceeding Target RIT on math MAP will be maintained at 50.6% or will increase.

Result: Our goal was not met with 49.7% of our students meeting their math goal.

Goal #2: During the 2016-2017 school year, the percentage of students (grades 6-8) meeting/exceeding Target RIT on reading MAP will be at 54.2% or higher.

Result: Our goal was met with 57.4% of our students meeting their reading goal.

Summary: This year has been another strong academic year for Northwood. While we fell marginally short of our math goal, the percentage of students meeting their target RIT goal was met in reading. With the continuation of Professional Learning Communities and the incorporation of

Personalized Learning in our classrooms, teachers will continue to use formative student data to improve teaching practices and differentiate instruction throughout the 2017-2018 school year to help increase achievement for all learners.
