2021-2022 SIC GOAL

The 2021-2022 goal of the Paris School Improvement Committee (SIC) is for students to “learn about themselves and their interests” through Social Emotional Learning (SEL) and how it relates to the Greenville County Schools Graduation Plus. The actions taken include organizing an SEL day for March 11, 2022. To prepare for this, we created an SEL website for the school that includes SEL resources, how to use ReThinkED, and task menus to help bridge the gap between what students are learning at school and the skills they need to carry home. SIC works with teachers, PTA, parents, and the community to create a plan of action. The actions taken include opportunities for staff, parents, and families to participate in SEL activities culminating in a school-wide SEL day.

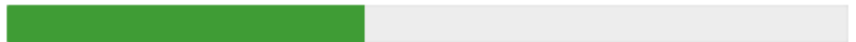

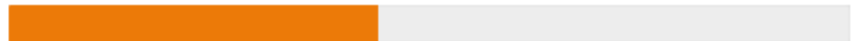


Mathematics

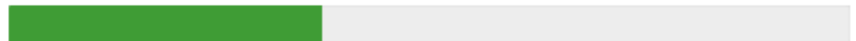

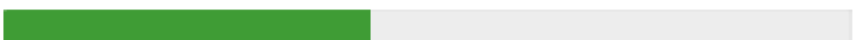
