At the start of the 2013-2014 school year we received an absolute rating of excellent, as well as a good in academic growth. We believe our success is due

to a strong emphasis of differentiation of instruction, integration of subjects and technology. Pelham Road Elementary is a unique blend of traditional studies and technology in a delightful, child friendly setting. Our motto, "A Community of Learners" is quite evident with our outstanding volunteer program comprised of parents and community members. Because of the dedication of our faculty and the commitment of our community, Pelham Road Elementary is definitely the epitome of a classic neighborhood school and a shining example of what all schools could be.

Standardized testing:

- Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) is a computer based test given in the fall and spring to 2nd—5th graders in math and ELA. MAP testing has benefited our school by providing detailed, individualized, immediate identification of strengths and weakness.
- Palmetto Assessment of State Standards (PASS) is the state test administered. Third through fifth grades take the writing portion in March. The reading and research, math science, and social studies portion is administered in May to all third through fifth graders.

SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT COUNCIL (S.I.C.)

SIC serves as an advisory body to the school's principal and faculty. The council works collaboratively to develop and implement a five-year school improvement plan. They also monitor and evaluate success in reaching the plan's objectives and to write an annual report to the parents about the progress of the plan. This year our SIC has been keeping abreast of policies, laws, and regulations enacted by local, state, and federal authorities that affect schools, especially those that might improve educational opportunities. SIC plays a key role in education, bringing together parents, educators, and community stakeholders to work collectively to improve our local school.
