## MISSION

The mission of Slater-Marietta Elementary School is to provide a quality education to build the foundation needed to grow academically and socially which in turn will empower each student to be responsible, productive citizens and future leaders.

## Performance Goals

Increase the percentage of students meeting standard (Met and Exemplary) in writing as measured by the SC Palmetto Assessment of State Standards (SCPASS) from 61.8% in 2012 to 82.8% in 2018

Increase the percentage of students meeting standard in English Language Arts (reading and research) as measured by the Palmetto Assessment of State Standards (PASS) from 78.1% in 2012 to 83.0% in 2018

Increase the percentage of students meeting standard in mathematics as measured by the Palmetto Assessment of State Standards (PASS) from 80.5% in 2012 to 92.5% in 2018

Increase the percentage of students meeting standard in science as measured by the Palmetto Assessment of State Standards (PASS) from 74.3% in 2012 to 86.3.0% in 2018

Increase the percentage of students meeting standard in social studies as measured by the Palmetto Assessment of State Standards (PASS) from 75.3% in 2012 to 83.9% in 2018
